### A message from Barbara, Pre-School Manager



The first half of the spring term has sped past. We have been lucky enough to have some lovely spring weather as well as some very wet weather! Looking ahead to the next half term:

- The option to drop children off early on a Tuesday and Wednesday morning, (between 8.15 and 8.30 am) either on a regular basis or occasionally, is still available
- Our Thursday morning session is very quiet and relaxed which the children really enjoy. They often comment on how quiet it is. There is plenty of space for them to move and spread out in when playing
- Spaces in our Monday, Wednesday and Thursday pre-school sessions mean that you are able to do one of these sessions on an ad-hoc basis if you find something cropping up on one of these days
- Children are able to join the Thursday afternoon session immediately after their second birthday. They can stay unaccompanied, or with a parent for as long as needed to settle them

We have appointed two new staff who will be starting with us after half term. Becky and La'Raine will be working on Tuesday and Friday in our mixed sessions as well as Thursday afternoon in our Rising 3 session. On a Friday morning, we have Robyn helping out.
